Elementary School Attendance Areas "Border Street Rules"

General: Major streets divide attendance areas. Residential streets will include both sides of the street when dividing attendance areas. On border streets with cul-de-sacs, the cul-de-sac street follows the same attendance rules as the border street (i.e. New Madrid is a border street where both sides attend Franklin. It also includes two cul-de-sacs. Children residing on these cul-de-sac streets would attend Franklin.)
